FG Declares Zamfara state No –Fly Zone. Aircraft that violate a no-fly zone maybe shut down by the enforcing state, depending on the terms of the no-fly zone.

KIDNAPPING: A National Security Challenge in Nigeria.

Kaduna airport under siege, as residents in official quarters, abducted by Terrorist groups terrorizing most part of the North East.

720 Kidnapped across Nigeria since the beginning of 2021, N10bn ransom paid.

- **Zamfara, Kaduna, Niger State** Worst Hit.
- **S/ East, S/South** record least cases
- Benin – Auchi, Zaria – Sokoto – Gusau, Benin – Ore, Keffi - Akwanga roads emerging Hotspots.

The finding which covered the six geopolitical zones of the zones, North – West led with more than 400 cases while North – Central had 250. The South –East had the least reported cases.

The total figure represents the confirmed cases by the Nigerian Police and eye witness account , as other unreported incidents may have taken place.

PATTERN

NORTH

The pattern of abduction remains the same in the North, where victims were often kidnapped en mass during attacks on remote villages and schools.

SOUTH/WEST and SOUTH/SOUTH

Highways in this region have become hot spots for kidnapers.

SOUTH/WEST

Herdsmen have been accused , in connection with most of the incidents, abductees were often abducted on the highways and forest while few took place in their farms.
